We are looking for ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) volunteer teachers to provide English language classes at our site in Colindale (Hyde House, the Hyde, NW96LH) during school term time, weekdays (between 10:00 and 3:00).

Hours: 2 hours per week for 40 weeks (plus preparation time).

Job Description:

You will be expected to deliver ESOL classes at levels Entry 1, 2 or 3 to groups of varying sizes, and maintain class records as required.

The learners are asylum seekers and refugees. Many of them are unable to access mainstream provision for a range of social and financial reasons. The BRS ESOL classes aim to support them in their daily lives, including finding work and accessing education and training.
